Students who have completed their junior year of high school may be considered for Early Admission. If accepted for Early Admission, the student would enter FAU as a freshman instead of attending high school for the senior year. Qualifications for consideration for Early Admission are:

1. 3.8 GPA (as calculated by FAU) after six semesters of high school.
2. An SAT of 1290 or an ACT of 27.
3. Written permission from their high school to allow FAU courses to satisfy any remaining requirements toward high school graduation.
4. Written recommendations attesting to students' maturity and readiness to meet the academic and personal challenges posed by early entry into higher education.
5. Must be a Florida resident.
6. Application and all supporting documents must be received in the Office of Admissions by April 15.

In addition to official high school transcripts and SAT or ACT testing results, you must also submit the following documents:

1. A completed FAU application for admissions with a \$30.00 non-refundable application fee
2. A personal letter outlining your reasons for pursuing an early admission opportunity at Florida Atlantic University.
3. A completed Supplemental Application and a Student Statement of Responsibility form.
4. If you are a home schooled student, you must submit an official copy of your letter of intent with your home school district
5. A list of the credits that you need to graduate from your high school
6. Statement of Legal Compliance and/or a Copy of SACS Accreditation (to be completed by nonpublic high schools or home school parent). This form is available at http://www.fau.edu/registrar/non_degree/pdf/docs/legalcompliance.pdf
7. Written recommendations
8. You must notify Freshman Advising of progress and the desire to continue at the end of each semester.
