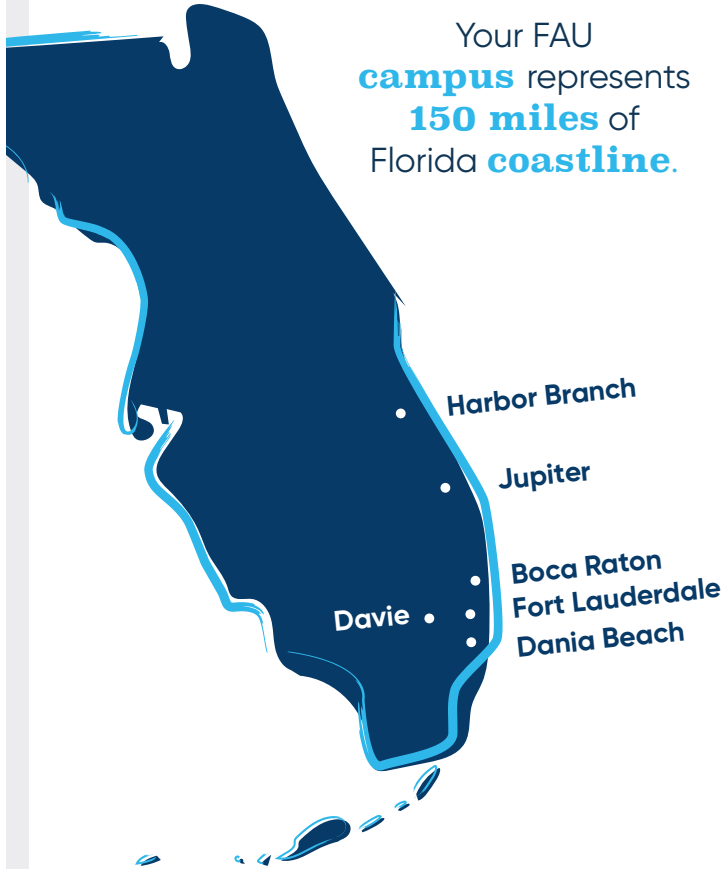

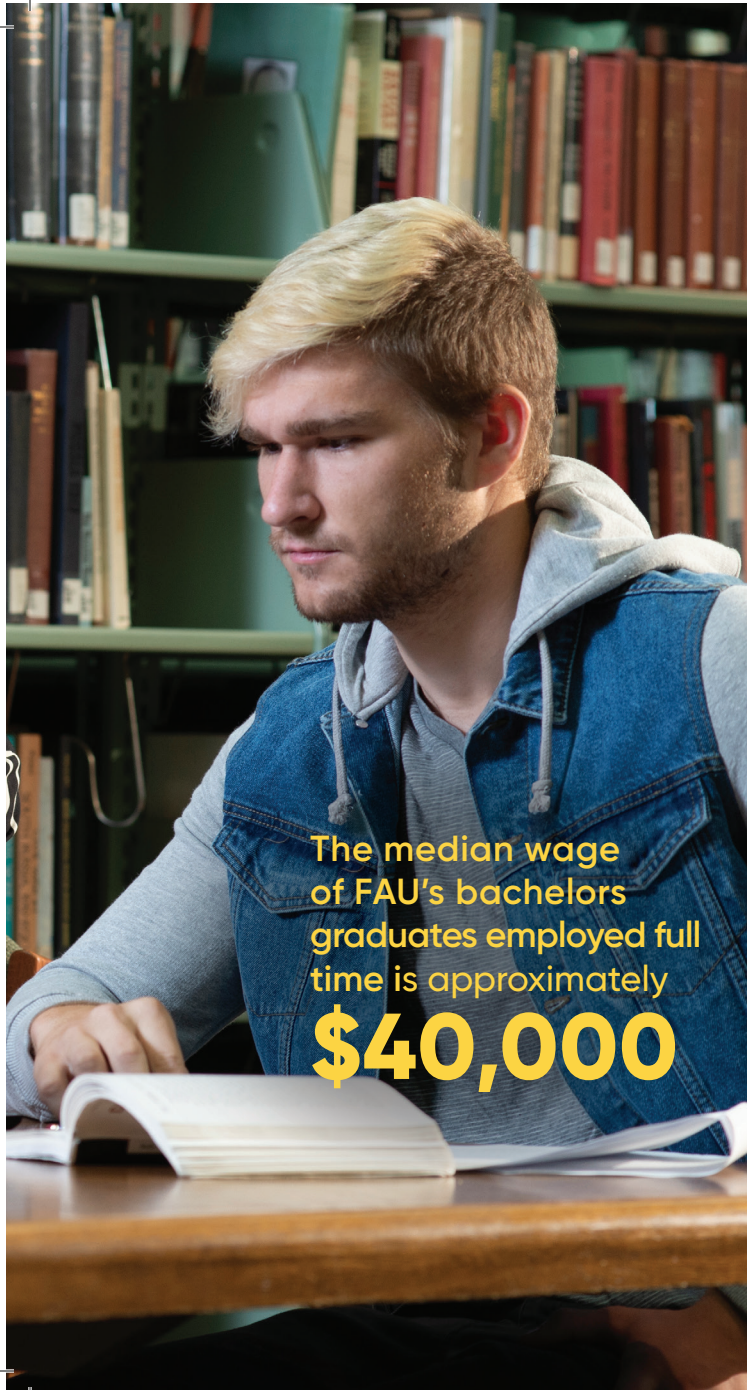
# Transfer Student Support

Our merit scholarships are competitive, and all are awarded for fall and spring semesters only. Students must be admitted to FAU in order to be considered for a scholarship. Some merit awards consider financial need as well as academic excellence, **filing your FAFSA is strongly encouraged.**

# Application Process

1. Complete an undergraduate admissions application at [apply.fau.edu](http://apply.fau.edu)
2. Submit the \$30 application fee with your application
3. Provide official college transcripts (for every college/institution attended)
4. If transferring with less than 60 credits, you may need to meet additional admissions requirements

**Note:** For international students, a certified English translation is required for all documents not issued in English. FAU can complete a course by course evaluation. Students may also submit a NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services) evaluation.
