

General Admission Requirements

Minimum graduate GPA of 3.0 (Masters or Specialist degree)

AND

• GRE scores from within the last 5 years are required, but there are no minimum sub-score requirements

Note: Meeting the minimum admission requirements does not guarantee admission to the program





Application Process – Part 1

Prepare:

- 1. Personal objective essay that identifies your career goals and how the school leaders PhD program will enable you to meet these goals
- 2. Professional résumé
- 3. Names and emails of three references
- 4. Your current email address (must have one upon entering the program)

Submit the above documents online as a part of your application.





Application Process – Part 2

- 2. Submit electronic transcripts and/or GRE scores to FAU Graduate Admissions

Admission Process

All application requirements filed by deadline (February 15th for Fall admission; there is no spring admission)

- Online application completed
- Application fee paid
- Official transcripts and GRE report received by Graduate College

Upon receipt of completed application:

- Committee reviews completed applications that meet the minimum requirements
- Individuals whose applications received a favorable review are invited to an interview
- Prompt for writing sample is sent via email the day before your interview
