The Higher Education Leadership Master's Degree (M.Ed.) program is designed for individuals aspiring to, or currently holding, higher education leadership positions.

The Higher Education Leadership Specialist Degree is for individuals wanting to specialize in leadership beyond the M.Ed. degree. The program includes some doctoral coursework but has no dissertation requirement.

The Higher Education Leadership Doctoral Degree (Ph.D.) program allows individuals to refine skills, initiate research, and approach challenges and opportunities to lead at the executive level in higher education.
