Educational Leadership and Research Methodology

The Wallace Foundation has selected Florida Atlantic University as one of seven universities to participate in a national \$47-million University Principal Preparation Initiative (UPPI). The initiative is designed to develop models over the next four years to improve university school principal preparation programs and encourage higher-quality training statewide. An independent study will capture lessons from the participating universities and their partners to be shared with policymakers and practitioners across the country. FAU, along with district partners and Florida Department of Education, will receive more than \$2.3 million for the first year, with a total possible four-year budget of more than \$5.6 million.

Teaching and Learning

The Department of Teaching and Learning is in its third and final year of the Centers of Excellence in Elementary Education Teacher Preparation EXCEED Grant. New content area courses will be offered in the Spring 2017 as part of the grant. The Department has been working on revising its Mission Statement and Goals. The Department has had its Reading Endorsement approved by the State of Florida for our undergraduate Elementary Ed. Program.
