## **MBA Entrepreneurship Concentration**

The MBA concentration in Entrepreneurship includes four courses. One course is an integrative capstone addressing all aspects of the venture creation process (see "Capstone" below). Another gives students in-depth knowledge of a particular aspect of that process (List A). A third provides students with exposure to a specific context (i.e., industry, sector, or area) where businesses are created (List B).
