  - Program changes to Honors Philosophy concentration (total number of credits for concentration: no change). Summary of the changes:
    - Replace PHI 4970 with IDS 4970 H Thesis
    - Remove the following courses from the list of electives: PHM 1002, PHH 3442, PHI 3224, PHI 4804
    - Add the following to the list of electives: PHH 3939, PHI 1933, PHI 2010, PHI 3653, PHI 3704, PHI 4906, PHI 4915, PHI 4959, POT 3021
  - Program changes to Honors Psychology concentration (total number of credits for concentration: no change) Summary of the changes:
    - Social science elective is dropped and replaced by elective under “Seminars and Adv Coursework in Psychology”
