<b>Policy</b>
<p>All work performed to a computer, will be by designated teams using approved tools, processes, and parts. Exceptions may be granted with the approval of the appropriate management team.</p> <p>This policy is not intended to nor will supersede in part or whole any policy of the Office of Information Technology.</p>

<b>Purpose and Description</b>
<p>This is to insure the delivery of safe, secure, and reliable performance to all users. Computer is any equipment that is in itself or is part of a computing system and may be property of Florida Atlantic University. In the cases of computers not owned by Florida Atlantic University but, approved for use within the University environment, the scope of services will be reduced as is appropriate.</p> <p>The Computer policy is intended to establish a standard for services delivered not limit options or flexibility.</p>
